MAHATHIR LEAVES FOR G15 SUMMIT

KUALA LUMPUR, Nov 2 (Bernama) --- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad today left for Zimbabwe to attend the G15 summit which begins in Harare tomorrow.

He is accompanied by his wife Datin Seri Dr Siti Hasmah Mohd Ali.

Deputy Prime Minister Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim and his wife Datin Seri Dr Wan Azizah Wan Ismail were at the Sultan Abdul Aziz Airport in Subang, near here, to see them off.

Several ministers and senior government officials were also present.

From Harare, Dr Mahathir leaves for an official visit to Guinea and Ghana from Nov 5 to 11.

G15, a grouping of developing countries, comprises Jamaica, India, Egypt, Venezuela, Argentina, Indonesia, Malaysia, Nigeria, Algeria, Peru, Mexico, Zimbabwe, Senegal, Brazil and Chile.

Eight heads of government and state have confirmed their attendance at the sixth summit. -- BERNAMA
