MALAWI PRESIDENT TO VISIT MALAYSIA

KUALA LUMPUR, Sept 3 (Bernama) -- Malawi President Dr Bakili Muluzi will arrive on Thursday for a three-day visit to strengthen bilateral relations.

Wisma Putra said in statement today that an agreement between the Malawi and Malaysian governments will be signed during the visit.

Several memoranda of understanding between private companies of the two countries are also expected to be signed.

During his stay, Dr Muluzi will have an audience with the Yang di-Pertuan Agong Tuanku Ja'afar and hold talks with Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad.

The Malawi leader will receive briefings at the Economic Planning Unit, the Malaysian Industrial Development Authority and the Federal Land Development Authority.

He is also scheduled to visit a low-cost housing scheme in Wangsa Maju and take part in a business seminar organised jointly with the National Chamber of Commerce and Industry. -- BERNAMA
