MALAYSIANS HELPING ZIMBABWE IN VARIOUS SECTORS, SAYS MUGABE

KUALA LUMPUR, July 31 (Bernama) -- Sunway City Berhad, a listed unit of the Sungei Way property group, is developing an industrial park in Zimbabwe which is also seeking Malaysian assistance to build a thermal power plant, Zimbabwe President Robert Mugabe said.

He said the projects are part of the cooperative efforts agreed by the two countries in various sectors.

"We will continue to send our ministers and officials to Malaysia and Kuala Lumpur too can send their experts in order to exchange ideas for the mutual benefits of both countries," he told reporters at the Sultan Abdul Aziz Shah International Airport in Subang today before leaving for home after a three-day visit.

Mugabe, who was in Malaysia to attend the Second Langkawi International Dialogue, was seen off by Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad.

Dr Mahathir said Malaysia and Zimbabwe are cooperating in various fields where Malaysia have some experience, like transportation, power generation, air services and industrial development.

Mugabe was accompanied by his Transport Minister Simon B. Moyo and Finance Minister Murerwa.

During his stay in Langkawi, Mugabe held bilateral talks with Dr Mahathir and met corporate leaders. -- BERNAMA
