MAMPU TO CONDUCT STUDY ON REVAMP OF YOUTH AND SPORTS MINISTRY

BAGAN DATOH, March 5 (Bernama) -- The Malaysian Administrative Modernisation and Management Planning Unit (Mampu) will conduct a study on the structural and human resources needs of the Youth and Sports Ministry in line with the proposal to revamp it.

Youth and Sports Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin said he had discussed the move with Mampu's director-general recently after the proposal to revamp the ministry was submitted to Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad.

Dr Mahathir had agreed that the number of the ministry's staff be increased in cooperation with the Public Services Commission, he told reporters after attending a Hari Raya party with Bagan Datoh Umno division members at Hutan Melintang, near here, last night.

He said the ministry's structure should be revamped since the existing set-up was 20 years behind time and no longer suitable to deal with the major issues affecting youths at present

He said youth issues were national issues and the ministry did not have enough manpower to deal with it at the state and district levels. --
