MANY COUNTRIES EMULATING MALAYSIA'S SYSTEM OF GOVERNANCE

KUALA LUMPUR, Sept 11 (Bernama) -- Malaysia's system of government is not only emulated by developing countries but developed countries also respected it, Dewan Rakyat Speaker Tan Sri Zahir Ismail said today.

He said many countries respected Malaysia as the country practised genuine parliamentary democracy system since attaining independence.

"There is no flaws in Malaysia's system of governance as evident from the country's prosperity and political stability," he told reporters after meeting Vietnam's National Assembly president Nong Duc Manh in his office at Parliament Building, here.

Duc Manh, who arrived here yesterday for a five-day visit, is scheduled to call on Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad tomorrow.

Meanwhile, Thailand's vice-president of the Senate Standing Committee on Administrative and Judicial Affairs Sansorn Kraichitti called on Dewan Negara president Datuk Adam Abdul Kadir.

Speaking to reporters later, Adam said Thailand was keen to learn Malaysia's administrative and judicial services. -- BERNAMA
