MELAKA PLANS TO BUILD MOSQUE IN BOSNIA-HERZEGOVINA

MELAKA, April 16 (Bernama) -- The Melaka government plans to build a RM1 million mosque in Bosnia-Herzegovina, Chief Minister Datuk Seri Mohamed Zin Abdul Ghani said today.

Speaking to reporters after opening a seminar on "Melaka, historical city and cultural state" here, he said a special fund to raise money for the construction of the building would be launched here by Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad on May 2.

The state government would bear the cost of building the mosque and donations from the corporate sector and individuals were also welcome, he said.

The mosque would be modelled after Masjid Al Azim, here, he added. --
