MEXICAN FOREIGN MINISTER ENDS VISIT

KUALA LUMPUR, July 2 (Bernama) -- Mexican Foreign Affairs Minister Dr Angel Gurria left today after a three-day official visit to enhance bilateral relations between Mexico and Malaysia.

During his visit he met Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad and had talks with Foreign Minister Datuk Abdullah Ahmad Badawi on bilateral, multilateral and international issues of common interest.

Malaysia and Mexico have agreed to sign avoidance of double taxation and investment guarantee agreements to boost bilateral trade and investment.

Dr Gurria's next stop is Jakarta. He will also visit Thailand, Singapore and Japan. -- BERNAMA
