PAHANG DONATES 60 HOUSES TO CAMBODIA

KUANTAN, May 9 (Bernama) -- The Pahang government has donated 60 houses to the newly established Samdech Hun Sen Development Centre in Phnom Penh.

Five completed houses were handed over yesterday to Cambodian Second Prime Minister Hun Sen by Pahang Menteri Besar Tan Sri Khalil Yaakob at a ceremony at the Krang Yov Commune, about 48km from Phnom Penh, according to a statement released here today.

The ceremony was attended by about 4,000 people.

It said Hun Sen thanked Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad for playing an important role in forging good relationship between the two countries.

Hun Sen described the houses as a big help to his country as well as further strengthening bilateral relations.

The Samdech Hun Sen Centre, a rehabilitation centre, was established last year. -- BERNAMA
