PAS LODGES POLICE REPORT ON SELANGOR MB'S CASE

SHAH ALAM, Dec 28 (Bernama) -- The PAS Youth today lodged a report with the Selangor Anti-Corruption Agency asking it to investigate the case of Selangor Menteri Besar Tan Sri Muhammad Muhamad Taib who was detained with an equivalent of RM2.4 million cash in his possession in Australia last Sunday.

Its secretary, Haji Mahfuz Omar, lodged the report at the state ACA office here accompanied by PAS Youth deputy permanent chairman Ismat Habib, treasurer Sheikh Abu Bakar Omar and several central and state PAS Youth exco members.

The report was submitted to state ACA senior investigating officer Haji Norazmi Nordin.

Mahfuz told reporters later that there was no evidence adduced in connection with the case and PAS Youth was only making the report asking the ACA to conduct an immediate and fair investigation.

He also said that Muhammad must make a full report not only to Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad but also to all the people who wanted to know where he got the money from. -- BERNAMA
