PM HAPPY OVER HIS MEETING WITH CUEPACS, SAYS AH LEK

KUALA LUMPUR, Oct 30 (Bernama) -- Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad is "very happy" on his meeting with Cuepacs yesterday and has directed the Public Services Department (PSD) to look into the requests and issues raised, Human Resources Minister Datuk Lim Ah Lek said today.

"The Prime Minister reported to the Cabinet today that he's very happy with his meeting with Cuepacs and I like to congratulate Cuepacs leaders for their open-mindedness and maturity," he told reporters.

Dr Mahathir had directed the PSD to look into the union's claims, he said when commenting on the outcome of the meeting held at the Prime Minister's Department yesterday.

Lim said the PSD would submit a report to Dr Mahathir after conducting a study on the requests by Cuepacs to review the pension scheme, housing allowance for civil servants and the matrix salary schedule.

Cuepacs secretary-general N. Siva Subramaniam said the union would submit a memorandum on its claims to the PSD in two weeks. -- BERNAMA
