PM PERFORMS GROUND-BREAKING FOR WORLD YOUTH COMPLEX

MELAKA, May 3 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad performed the ground-breaking ceremony for the RM50 million World Youth Foundation (WYF) Complex in Ayer Keroh here today, the second day of his two-day working visit to Melaka.

The complex, when completed at the end of 1998, will be an international youth service centre equipped with facilities like a hotel, hostel and conference halls.

The WYF was set up on May 10 1994 with the aim of promoting research, documentation and development programmes that are beneficial to youths.

Present at the ceremony were Melaka Chief Minister Datuk Seri Mohd Zin Abdul Ghani, Youth and Sports Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin and Deputy Transport Minister Datuk Mohd Ali Rustam, who is WYF Chairman and World Assembly of Youth President.
