PM PRAISES GOOD BEHAVIOUR OF MALAYSIANS AT JACKO CONCERT

KUALA LUMPUR, Oct 31 (Bernama) -- Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad has praised the good behaviour of Malaysians who attended the concert of pop megastar Michael Jackson at Merdeka Stadium on Sunday and Tuesday.

The audiences at the two-day concert showed that Malaysians are disciplined, the Prime Minister said when he addressed more than 3,000 employees of Tenaga Nasional Berhad during his visit to the utility company today.

"There were no incidents during the concert. He (Michael Jackson) spoke of the importance of preserving the environment. That's Okay. He's Okay and our people are Okay," he said to laughter and cheers by the TNB employees.

He cited the concert to illustrate his point on the need for the country to remain peaceful and stable and the people to be disciplined in order to continue attracting foreign investors.

"If we are poor, nobody would want to come here.

"I hear concerts by Michael Jackson in some other countries did not receive as good response as here. This is because we can afford to see (his concert)," he said.
