PM SAYS MEETING WILL CONSIDER REDUCING INTAKE OF BANGLADESHI WORKERS

KUALA LUMPUR, Oct 4 (Bernama) -- The National Security Council (NSC) will consider at its meeting this month the possibility of Malaysia reducing the intake of Bangladeshi workers.

This was announced by Prime Minister and Umno president Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad after chairing the Umno Spreme Council monthly meeting here tonight.

"Supreme Council members view seriously the social problems created by workers from that country," he told reporters.

The members gave their views on the problem during the hour-long meeting and left it to the NSC to take appropriate action when it meets in the middle of this month, he said. -- BERNAMA
