POLISH PRIME MINISTER LEAVES FOR HOME

KUALA LUMPUR, March 24 (Bernama) -- Polish Prime Minister Dr Wlodzimierz Cimoszewicz and his delegation left here today after a three-day official visit to the country.

Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad and his wife, Datin Seri Dr Siti Hasmah Mohamed Ali, were at the Sultan Abdul Aziz Shah Airport to bid them farewell.

Also present were Deputy Foreign Minister Datuk Leo Michael Toyad, who was minister-in-attendance, Deputy Works Minister Datuk Railey Jeffrey, and senior government officials.

During the visit, the Polish and Malaysian governments signed an economic, scientific and technical cooperation agreement while the private sector of both countries signed five memoranda of understanding.

Dr Cimoszewicz and his delegation arrived on Friday to enhance bilateral relations between Poland and Malaysia especially in investment and trade. He was the first Polish prime minister to visit the country. -- Bernama
