SANUSI SAYS HE FORGIVES THE ASSEMBLYMEN WHO OPPOSED HIM

ALOR SETAR, June 21 (Bernama) -- Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Sanusi Junid said he has forgiven the 22 Kedah assemblymen from Umno who sent a memorandum in March to the Prime Minister to oppose his appointment.

He said he forgave their action in sending the memorandum and their attempts to tarnish his name.

Sanusi said he knew everything that happened and what was spoken about him.

"All sorts of things were said to slander me," he told a gathering of Kedah Barisan Nasional assembly members here last night.

He hoped the actions would not be repeated and the events need not be mentioned again.

"It is enough. We will close this story and consider the experience as a lesson to us."

The 22 assemblymen, who signed the memorandum and gave copies to the media before the Prime Minister could receive it, had wanted former Menteri Besar Tan Sri Osman Aroff to be retained in the post and objected to his replacement by Sanusi.

Prime Minister and Umno president Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad called their action discourteous.

The assemblymen later apologised to Dr Mahathir for their action. --
