SEVEN DISQUALIFIED FROM UMNO ELECTIONS

KUALA LUMPUR, Oct 7 (Bernama) -- Six candidates have been disqualified from contesting for Umno Supreme Council posts and another for the Youth Exco at the party's general assembly this week.

Umno deputy president Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim, who announced this, said the decision was made by the Umno special committee on the party election which met today under the chairmanship of party president Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad.

Those disqualified from the Supreme Council contest are Pulau Pinang Deputy Chief Minister Datuk Mohd Shariff Omar, Shah Alam Member of Parliament Datuk Salamon Salamat and four state executive councillors.

They are Datuk Mohd Aini Taib (Selangor), Datuk Dr Latif Mirasa (Pulau Pinang), Datuk Dr Abdul Malek Hanapiah (Perak) and Adam Abdul Hamid (Johor).

The candidate disqualified for the Youth Exco contest is Ayub Mat Aris (Selangor). -- BERNAMA
