SINGAPORE BUSINESSMEN TO VISIT KL

SINGAPORE, Aug 7 (Bernama) -- A 70-member trade and investment mission comprising senior Singapore businessmen will visit Malaysia for three days from Aug 13.

The group, led by Singapore Confederation of Industries (SCI) president Datuk Robert Chua, is making the visit at the invitation of the Malaysian Ministry of International Trade and Industry.

SCI senior director Emmeline Lam said today the group's programme included a meeting with Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad as well as a dialogue session with Minister for International Trade and Industry Datuk Seri Rafidah Aziz.

The Singapore delegation will also attend the official opening of the Singapore Trade and Development Board office in Kuala Lumpur by STDB chief executive officer Barry Desker.

The mission is jointly organised by SCI, Malaysian High Commission in Singapore and STDB.
