SLOW DOWN THE PACE OF DEVELOPMENT IN CITY CENTRE, SAYS PM

KUALA LUMPUR, May 10 (Bernama) -- Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad said today the government feels that the pace of development in the city centre should be slowed down and the construction of skyscrapers shelved while measures are taken to overcome the traffic congestion problem.
