SOUTH KOREAN PRESIDENT ENDS VISIT TO MALAYSIA

KUALA LUMPUR, NOV 28 (Bernama) -- South Korean President Kim Young Sam today left for Seoul after a three-day state visit to Malaysia.

Present at the Sultan Abdul Aziz Shah International Airport in Subang to see him off were Foreign Minister Datuk Abdullah Ahmad Badawi and Minister in the Prime Minister's Department Datuk Abang Abu Bakar Mustapha who is the minister-in-attendance.

Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad and his wife Datin Paduka Dr Siti Hasmah Mohd Ali earlier made a farewell call on Kim and his wife Son Myung Ja at the Hilton Hotel here.

Kim and his wife also paid a farewell call on the Yang di-Pertuan Agong Tuanku Ja'afar and Raja Permaisuri Agong Tuanku Najihah at the Istana Negara.

Kim arrived on Tuesday from the Philippines where he had attended the summit of the Asia Pacific Economic Cooperation (Apec).

Malaysia was the last leg of his three-nation tour of Southeast Asia which also took him to Vietnam. -- BERNAMA
