STUDENT KILLED IN CAR ACCIDENT IN CANADA BURIED

JOHOR BAHRU, Feb 25 (Bernama) -- The Malaysian student in Canada, who died following a road accident on the Montreal-Ottawa Highway last Tuesday, was buried at the Mahmoodiah cemetery here today.

The remains of Nor Azmi Ismail, 21, an engineering student at Concordia University in Montreal, which was flown back to Malaysia, had earlier arrived by van from Kuala Lumpur at 4.45am.

The Malaysian Students' Department director in Canada, Haji Saaban Muksan, accompanied the body.

Nor Azmi and a friend Wan Nazaruddin were travelling in a car driven by another friend Mahathir Abdullah, when it was involved in a collision with a truck on the first day of Hari Raya.

Nor Azmi, who was in the front seat, suffered serious head injuries and died in hospital.

His father, Ismail Kassim, 45, said: "I disapproved of Nor Azmi having an international driving licence but fate decreed that he was to die in a car driven by his friend." -- BERNAMA
