UMNO GENERAL ASSEMBLY ENTERS FINAL DAY

KUALA LUMPUR, Oct 12 (Bernama) -- The Umno general assembly at the Putra World Trade Centre here entered its final day today with the tabling of the motion on religion.

The motion will be tabled by the representative from Terengganu, Mustapha Muda.

The delegates yesterday debated on and adopted the motion on education and the motion of thanks on the president, Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad's, opening speech.

The education motion was tabled by the Umno Youth representative, Mohamed Khaled Nordin and seconded by the representative from Sabah, Azizi Mohamed Nor.

The assembly started on Thursday with the election of key party posts. This was preceded by the Youth and Wanita assemblies on Wednesday.

At the start of today's proceedings Tan Sri Sulaiman Ninam Shah listed the Umno membership for the various states.

Sabah has the most members with 355,126 followed by Johor (350,893), Selangor (288,197), Perak (234,220), Kedah (219,156), Kelantan (198,836), Pahang (175,015), Terengganu (146,796), Pulau Pinang (112,318), Negeri Sembilan (108,904), Federal Territory (97,949), Melaka (81,070) and Perlis (42,273).

Silam in Sabah is the division with the most members with 34,232, followed by Gombak (28,295), Beaufort (28,197), Libaran (27,586), Semporna (27,287) and Sri Gading (26,337). -- BERNAMA
