UMNO LIFTS SUSPENSION ON 13 MEMBERS INCLUDING A FORMER CABINET MINISTER

KUALA LUMPUR, Aug 3 (Bernama) --Thirteen Umno members including former Cabinet Minister Datuk Shahrir Samad, are now back in the fold after suspension orders on their membership were lifted by the party today.

Party deputy president Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim said today the party supreme council allowed their appeals, after earlier reference to the party's technical committee, the Deputy Prime Minister told reporters after the supreme council meeting at the Umno headquarters here today.

It was chaired by Prime Minister and party president Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad.

Apart from Shahrir, who belongs to the Johor Baharu Division, other members are Muhammad Awang (Rantau Panjang), Salimin Kisut (Johor Baharu), Haji Hashim Hamzah (Pasir Mas), Abd Lah Sani (Gombak) Rifai Mikin (Gombak).

Senator Isli Siput (Labuan), Umar Mokhtar (Taiping), Rokiah Mat Amin (Taiping), Muhammad Noh Padidin (Kuala Langat), Wan Yaakub Wan Sulaiman (Pasir Putih), Abdul Kulop Badok (Taiping) and Haji Ibrahim Mat (Grik). -

On the resolutions for the party general assembly in October, Anwar said Pahang would be the proposer for the thank you vote on the presidential address with Selangor would second it.
