UMNO YOUTH HOUSING PANEL TO MEET STATE GOVTS

SHAH ALAM, July 24 (Bernama) -- Umno Youth land and low-cost housing Distribution sub-committee will start meeting the state governments next month to gather information on the major problems related to the two issues.

Its chairman Datuk Abdul Fatah Iskandar said all information on the award of land and low-cost houses to the low-income groups would be collated and analysed.

The report would be submitted to Umno president Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad, his deputy Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim and Supreme Council members, he told reporters at his office here today.

Under the youth movement's special programme, all 165 Youth divisions were required to report major problems related to land and low-cost house distribution in their respective areas.

After analysing the report, he said the sub-committee would have dialogues with the relevant authorities to find the best solution to resolve the problems.

Abdul Fatah, who is Selangor Umno Youth leader, said the sub-committee was expected to complete its work including meeting the state governments in October.

The sub-committee also planned to have dialogues with ministries, departments, agencies and private sector to offer its views on the matter.

He said it was important to ensure that problems faced by the people especially the low-income poor be given due attention so that they would not feel neglected. -- BERNAMA
