YAP KIM HOCK ADVANCES INTO THIRD ROUND

ALOR SETAR, Sept 12 (Bernama) -- National doubles player Yap Kim Hock playing in the men's singles of the Kedah Open Badminton Proton-Eon 1996 Circuit today advanced into the third round after easily overcoming his opponent.
