ANDHRA PRADESH CHIEF MINISTER TO VISIT MALAYSIA

NEW DELHI, May 8 (Bernama) -- The chief minister of the southern state of Andhra Pradesh, Chandrababu Naidu, will lead a high-level delegation to Malaysia and Singapore next week to woo investors to the state.

Naidu, who is leading a big delegation of politicians, senior officials and representatives of trade and commerce, will meet Malaysian Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad on Monday and Singaporea Prime Minister Goh Chok Tong on May 16.

According to the English daily, the Hindu, the visit, among other things, is to study the development strategies and implementation of programmes that have helped the two countries achieve amazing economic growth and put them on par with the advanced and affluent world.

The delegation will leave for Kuala Lumpur on Sunday and will be in Malaysia until May 15 before proceeding to Singapor for a two-day visit. --
