ANWAR CANCELS SABAH TRIP

KUALA LUMPUR, Nov 21 (Bernama -- Deputy Prime Minister Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim has cancelled a one-day visit to Sabah scheduled tomorrow, his press secretary Adlin Zabri said today.

This was because Anwar and Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad have to attend to urgent matters, Adlin said.

" The Deputy Prime Minister apologises for the inconvenience caused by the cancellation," Adlin said.

Anwar was originally scheduled to meet the Sabah Umno liaison committee and state Barisan Nasional leaders in Kota Kinabalu tomorrow besides launching a low-cost housing project in Putatan.-- BERNAMA
