ASSOCIATION DEPLORES CONGRESSMAN'S MOVE AGAINST DR MAHATHIR

KUALA LUMPUR, Nov 12 (Bernama) -- The Malaysian Administrative and Diplomatic Service Association today deplored a move by a United States Congressman to table a resolution against Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad.

"The association feels strongly that this sort of move must not only be stopped but it should be deplored at the highest," its president Datuk Dr Johari Mat said in a statement.

Johari said the association was against foreign interference targeted at the democratically-elected Malaysian leadership.

He was commenting on the move by US Congressman Robert Wexler to sponsor a resolution which called on Dr Mahathir to "apologise or resign" over his reported remarks that a Jewish conspiracy was behind the currency crisis in Southeast Asia.

Johari said: "This move not only challenges the sovereignty and rights of a nation but seems also to be very arrogant and high-handed. This move disregards the spirit of international friendship." -- BERNAMA
