BN SUPREME COUNCIL MEETING ON AUG 9

KLUANG, Aug 2 (Bernama) -- The Barisan Nasional Supreme Council will hold its first meeting for this year next Saturday, BN secretary-general Datuk Mohamed Rahmat said today.

He said it would be a normal meeting and chaired by Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad, who is the BN chairman.

At the meeting to be held at the Putra World Trade Centre, BN component party leaders are expected to be briefed on recent measures adopted by the government, Mohamed told reporters after launching a meet-the-people gathering at Felda Kahang Timur near here.

Mohamed, who is also Information Minister, said among the subjects likely to be discussed were corruption, power abuse and the proposal for the standardised implementation of Islamic laws in all states. -- BERNAMA
