Chinese New Year open house round up

KUALA LUMPUR, Wed. - Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad and other Cabinet Ministers have been invited to MCA's Chinese New Year open house which will be held at the party's headquarters on the first day of Chinese New Year.

Parti Gerakan Malaysia will hold its open house from 10am to 1pm the same day at its headquarters at Jalan Pudu Ulu while its president Datuk Seri Lim Keng Yaik will hold his open house in Ayer Tawar, Perak on Monday.

Sabah Chief Minister and the Progressive Party's president Datuk Yong Teck Lee and his wife Datin Stella will hold their Chinese New Year open house on Saturday at the Likas Sports Complex from 10am to 2pm.

Liberal Democratic Party's president and Minister in the Prime Minister's Department Datuk Chong Kah Kiat's Chinese New Year open house will be from 5pm to 9pm on Saturday at his Taman Chin Sang residence in Jalan Tuaran.

Since Chinese New Year falls on a fasting day, Chinese leaders in Kelantan will delay holding their open houses so that their Muslim friends could also share in the celebration.

In Sarawak, Science, Technology and Environment Minister Datuk Law Hieng Ding will be holding a joint open house in Sarikei with State Assistant Minister of Environment and Housing Datuk David Teng on the first day as well.

The State's Deputy Chief Minister Datuk Dr George Chan Hong Nam will hold joint open houses with Housing and Local Government Deputy Minister Peter Chin and Senadin State Assemblyman Lee Kim Sin on Friday.

Penang's Chief Minister Tan Sri Dr Koh Tsu Koon will also host his open house on Friday as well.
