Commonwealth sec-gen on five-day visit

PETALING JAYA, Fri. - Commonwealth Secretary-General Chief Emeka Anyaoku arrived today for a five-day visit.

He was met at the Sultan Abdul Aziz Shah International Airport by Md Hussin Nayan, the Foreign Ministry's under-secretary of Multilateral Political Affairs.

A Wisma Putra spokesman said Anyaoku's visit was to hold consultations with Malaysian leaders ahead of the Commonwealth Heads of Government Meeting in Edinburgh, Scotland in October.

Anyaoku later called on Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad. He will also call on Deputy Prime Minister Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim and Foreign Minister Datuk Abdullah Ahmad Badawi.

The Commonwealth Secretary-General will head for South Africa from here.
