CUEPACS TO PROPOSE NEW PAY STRUCTURE FOR CIVIL SERVANTS NEXT FEBRUARY

KOTA BAHARU, Dec 27 (Bernama) -- Cuepacs will present its proposal for a new salary structure for civil servants to the government next February.

Deputy president Mohamed Yusof Harmanshah said today the proposal paper would be ready soon.

"In the proposal, we included the proposal to scrap the New Remuneration Scheme," he told reporters after the launch of the 17th delegates conference of the Amalgamated National Union of Local Authorities Employees (Anulae), here.

He said that under the present scheme, the civil servants had three salary rungs, P1, P2 and P3 but under the proposal, Cuepacs wanted only one rung ending with a maximum at P3 for every category.

Cuepacs also proposed that the increment based on horizontal, vertical or diagonal movement to be scrapped as it had caused unhappiness among the civil servants, he said.

He said Cuepacs would also suggest that ceremonies for staff receiving vertical and horizontal increments be scrapped because it was a wastage.

Meanwhile, Anulae president Abdul Rahman Kadir thanked the government for not rejecting outright the union's proposal on a new formula for pension calculation and for the housing allowance to be increased from RM90 to RM230.

He said that at a meeting between the union and Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad recently, the Public Services Department was asked to study the proposal. -- BERNAMA
