Daim, Halim head Selangor honours list

KLANG, Fri. - Economic Adviser to the Government Tun Daim Zainuddin and Chief Secretary to the Government Datuk Paduka Abdul Halim Ali head the list of 747 recipients of awards from the Sultan of Selangor in conjunction with his 71st birthday tomorrow.

Daim and Halim will be conferred the Darjah Kebesaran Seri Paduka Mahkota Selangor (Kelas Pertama) which carries the title Datuk.

Only one recipient, businessman Datuk Count Jacob Sigamoney, will receive the Darjah Kebesaran Seri Sultan Salahuddin Abdul Aziz Shah (Kelas Pertama) with the title Datuk.
