DEPUTY IGP MAKES FAREWELL CALL ON PM

KUALA LUMPUR, March 24 (Bernama) -- Deputy Inspector-General of Police Tan Sri Samsuri Arshad, who retires next month, today paid a farewell visit on Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad.

Samsuri, who is due to retire on May 5, met Dr Mahathir at his office for about 20 minutes.
