DJIBOUTI FOREIGN MINISTER TO VISIT MALAYSIA TOMORROW

KUALA LUMPUR, May 2 (Bernama) -- Djibouti Foreign Minister Mohamed Moussa Chehem will arrive here tomorrow for a four-day official visit.

Mohamed Moussa will be accompanied by the ministry's secretary-general and the republic's ambassador to Japan.

He is expected to hand over an invitation from Djibouti's president to Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad to attend a round table meeting on the reconstruction of the republic's economy in Geneva.

Mohamed Moussa will also meet Deputy Prime Minister Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim and Foreign Minister Datuk Abdullah Ahmad Badawi before attending briefing sessions by officials from the Economic Planning Unit, Petronas, Malaysia-South-South Association and Malaysia International Shipping Corporation. -- BERNAMA
