DR MAHATHIR TO BREAK FAST AT SINTOK ON THURSDAY

ALOR SETAR, Jan 28 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad is scheduled to break fast at the mosque of Universiti Utara Malaysia (UUM) in Sintok on Thursday.

According to his personal representative in Kubang Pasu, Saad Hashim, Dr Mahathir would earlier witness the signing of an agreement between Bank Bumiputra Malaysia Berhad (BBMB) and UUM for the setting up of a "BBMB Chair" to promote research and academic excellence at the university.

He said that Dr Mahathir, would, on his arrival here that afternoon, attend a presentation of Hari Raya gifts by Bakti to the poor by his wife, Datuk Seri Siti Hasmah Mohamed Ali, at their residence in Titi Gajah, and later visit Pekan Rabu.

Dr Mahathir is scheduled to visit Langkawi to observe development projects on Monday and break fast at Masjid Padang Lalang.

He is scheduled to return here three days later to break fast at the Kepala Batas mosque. -- BERNAMA
