Dr M, Herzog discuss co-operation

KUALA LUMPUR, Wed. - Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad and German President Roman Herzog today discussed the possibility of co-operating in several fields, including education and training.

The Prime Minister said Malaysia wanted to study the German education system which emphasised practical training.

He said more students could be sent to Germany as there were now learning institutions there which used English as the medium of instruction.

They also discussed bilateral ties and possible areas of co-operation in trade and human resource training and Dr Mahathir gave his views on Asean, Europe and our position on Myanmar.

Herzog arrived yesterday for a five-day visit with a 100-member delegation and also visited a special youth football training session at the Police Depot ground.
