EXCO RESHUFFLE NO LINK TO ACA PROBE, SAYS MELAKA CM

MELAKA, April 19 (Bernama) -- Chief Minister Datuk Seri Mohd Zin Abdul Ghani said today the reshuffle of the state Exco has no connection to the Anti-Corruption Agency (ACA) probe against its three members.

He said it is a normal process aimed at streamlining the portfolios of the eight Exco members.

The reshuffle would be carried out after his discussion with Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad to be held soon, he told reporters after opening the annual convention of the Lion Club here.

To a question, he said none of the Exco members had expressed wishes to resign.

"None has been found guilty. Furthermore, it is normal for the ACA to investigate complaints received," he said.

Apart from the three state Exco members, five others also under probe by the ACA for alleged corruption and misuse of authority are one each from Johor, Selangor, Pahang, Kedah and Sabah. -- BERNAMA
