Exhibition attracting scores of visitors

KOTA BARU, Sun. - An exhibition of photographs illustrating political leaders and Umno members' sacrifices is attracting scores of people here.

A large number of people have visited the exhibition which is being held in the foyer of the State Economic Development Corporation's building in Jalan Petra Semarak.

The five-day New Straits Times photo exhibition which opened yesterday features more than 100 photographs, including 24 on Kelantan Umno activities, and 20 Lat cartoons.

The exhibition is being organised together with Kelantan Umno and Fujicolor.

It is being sponsored by Sime Bank Bhd, the Federal Agricultural Marketing Authority, The Store, Juita Inn, Sutera Inn.
