FIRST CLASS HONOUR AWARD FOR DAIM AND ABDUL HALIM

SHAH ALAM, March 7 (Bernama) -- The Economic Adviser to the Government Tun Daim Zainuddin and Chief Secretary to the Government Datuk Abdul Halim Ali head the list of 747 recipients of state awards and decorations in conjunction with the 71st birthday of the Sultan of Selangor tomorrow.

Both of them have been bestowed the "Darjah Kebesaran Seri Paduka Mahkota Selangor" (SPMS) (First Class) which carries the title "Datuk".

A total of 76 others are also made "Datuk", one receiving the "Darjah Kebesaran Seri Sultan Salahuddin Abdul Aziz Shah (SSSA) (Second Class), 11 the "Darjah Kebesaran Dato' Paduka Mahkota Selangor" (DPMS) (Second Class) and 57 the "Darjah Kebesaran Dato' Sultan Salahuddin Abdul Aziz Shah (DSSA) (Second Class).
