FIVE MALAYSIANS FOR AEROSPACE STUDIES IN FRANCE

KUALA LUMPUR, June 25 (Bernama) -- The Malaysian Industry-Government Group for High Technology (Might) will send five Malaysians to France tomorrow to attend a six-month aerospace course and a one-year post graduate programme.

Might is sending them in collaboration with the Institute Aeronautique et Spatial (IAS) of France.

The five are Zaidi Mohd Zain and Che Faridah Mat Taib from the Institut Teknologi Mara, Iskandar Shah Ishak and Shabudin Mat from Universiti Teknologi Malaysia and V.Renuganth from Universiti Putra Malaysia, according to a statement from Might.

The cooperation between Might and IAS follows a memorandum of understanding on human resource development signed in 1995.

Might which was launched Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad in 1993, is aimed at encouraging high-technology growth in this country. --
