Four Bills to be tabled at next Parliament meeting

KUALA LUMPUR, Tues. - Four Bills, to date, are confirmed for tabling during the first meeting of the third session of the Ninth Parliament which begins on March 24.

A Parliament spokesman said two of the Bills will be tabled by the Energy, Telecommunications and Posts Ministry.

They are the Computer Crimes Bill 1997 and the Digital Signature Bill 1997.

The other two Bills are the Supplementary Supply (1996 and 1997) Bill 1997 and the Copyright (Amendment) Bill 1997.

The Parliament session will be opened by the Yang di-Pertuan Agong Tuanku Ja'afar also on March 24.

He will be greeted on arrival by Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad and Deputy Prime Minister Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim.

The King will then inspect a guard-of-honour before proceeding to the opening ceremony and address both the members of the Dewan Rakyat and Dewan Negara.

He will be accompanied to the opening ceremony by the Raja Permaisuri Agong Tuanku Najihah.

The Dewan Rakyat meetings would be held from Mondays to Thursdays until May 7 while the Dewan Negara will meet from May 12 to June 5.
