FOURTH ASIA-KYUSHU SUMMIT AIMS TO ENHANCE CO-OPERATION

LANGKAWI, Nov 14 (Bernama) -- The fourth Asia-Kyushu Regional Exchange Summit, to be opened by Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad here tomorrow, would discuss ways to promote further mutual exchanges and co-operation among the participating regions.

Three days of discussions would focus on concrete steps to facilitate regional exchanges and transfer of technology from the more developed to the less developed regions, the summit organisers said in a statement today.

Participants are drawn from the various provinces of Japan, the countries of Thailand, Vietnam, the Philippines, South Korea, Indonesia, China and the state of Kedah.

The "One Village One Product Movement," which had been actively promoted by the participating regions, is also on the agenda.

About 350 people are expected to attend the summit. -- BERNAMA
