Ghapur has second thoughts on resignation

KOTA KINABALU, Sun. - Merotai Assemblyman Datuk Abdul Ghapur Salleh said he would take the advice of Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad to reconsider his decision to resign from the State Cabinet.

Speaking to reporters at his house in Likas, Ghapur, who met Dr Mahathir yesterday, said he would need some time to make a decision on the matter.

Ghapur tendered his resignation as Deputy Chief Minister and Finance Minister on Dec 13. He also tendered his resignation as Sabah Umno deputy liaison chief.

His resignation from the State Cabinet was supposed to have been effective on Dec 18 and as Sabah Umno deputy head on Dec 13.
