Guiding pupils down memory lane

GUESS WHO? ... Teachers Sokmawati Ibrahim and Suhaza Ghazali explain a 1950s photograph to 25 pre-schoolers and five pupils of Sekolah Kebangsaan Kelibang (Sekolah Khas) at the New Straits Times photography exhibition on Pulau Langkawi's development.

The picture was one of 120 photographs, newspaper cuttings and cartoons featured in the exhibition, organised by the NST and the Langkawi Development Authority in conjunction with the island's 10th year of duty-free status.

The 10-day exhibition at the Lada Complex in Kuah was launched by Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad on July 28 and is open from 9am to 9pm. Admission is free.
