HUNGARIAN PRIME MINISTER VISITS LANGKAWI'S ATTRACTIONS

LANGKAWI, April 20 (Bernama) -- Hungarian Prime Minister Gyula Horn, who arrived here last night for a private visit ahead of his two-day official visit to Malaysia, visited some of the island resort's attractions today.

Horn, accompanied by his wife, Deputy Defence Minister Datuk Dr Abdullah Fadzil Che Wan, who is minister-in-attendance, and Langkawi Development Authority (Lada) general manager Datuk Abdul Halil Mutalib, spent about an hour at Dataran Lang and Taman Lagenda.

Tonight, Horn will attend a dinner hosted by the state government.

Tomorrow, Horn will leave for Kuala Lumpur and be accorded a ceremonial welcome at Parliament Square.

He and Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad is scheduled to hold discussions before witnessing the signing of a bilateral agreement on scientific and technological cooperation between Hungary and Malaysia.

Horn will also attend a dinner hosted by Dr Mahathir at Sri Perdana, the Prime Minister's official residence.

He will also have an audience with Yang di-Pertuan Agong Tuanku Ja'afar and attend a briefing at the Economic Planning Unit in the Prime Minister's Department. -- BERNAMA
