Kelantan Umno's 13-point reformation plan

KOTA BARU, Thurs. - Kelantan Umno today outlined a 13-point reformation plan to gain the confidence of the people.

Its deputy liaison chief Datuk Annuar Musa said it included the need for Kelantan Umno to adopt a new image to enable it to play a more effective role and win back the State Government.

Opening the two-day State Umno/Barisan Nasional Convention, he said, Umno members must be willing to change and improve themselves by carrying out the reformation plan.

Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad, who is also Kelantan Umno liaison chief, will close the convention at Cherang Ruku in Semerak, Pasir Puteh, tomorrow.

The reformation, he said, could be carried out if all members were united, worked as a team, were caring and proactive.

He said the establishment of the political reformation and inculcating a new culture in Umno and Barisan Nasional were in line with the people's hope to see change in the State's political scenario.

Annuar said it was time for Umno to show greater commitment and to formulate a special agenda to enable the State to achieve greater success.
