KLSE's big do

THE Kuala Lumpur Stock Exchange (KLSE) is organising the Third Malaysia Capital Growth Opportunities Exposition 1997 - Meeting the Challenges of the Next Millennium from August 14-17, 1997 at the Putra World Trade Centre (PWTC), Kuala Lumpur. It will be officially opened by the Deputy Prime Minister, Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim on the first day.

This will mark the beginning of the celebrations which are being held to commemorate the official opening of the KLSE's new building by the Prime Minister, Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad on August 15, 1997.

KLSE expects this exposition to be the biggest yet with over 160 companies having confirmed their participation to date. The first one was held in 1990, followed by the second in 1993, both of which attracted participation from capital market and securities industry's players and attendance from local and foreign fund managers, analysts, stockbrokers, regulators, investors and the general public.

A gathering of listed companies, stockbroking companies, regulatory authorities, the equity and derivative exchanges, financial institutions and information vendors, the Expo offers an opportunity for them to offer insights into the operations of their respective organisations. The Expo has a dual objective. The first, targeted for members of the public, this will be a unique occasion to become familiar with all the major components of the capital market and to discover about investment opportunities in Malaysia.

The second aim is to enable participants to showcase their activities and performance so as to allow investors to gain a clearer comprehension of their organisations. In line with the theme for this year, participating companies are each expected to demonstrate their levels of preparedness in meeting the challenges of the new millennium.

A distinct feature in this year's Expo will be the Company Sessions program where participating companies will hold presentations on their companies. Though the sessions are targeted mainly at local and foreign fund managers and analysts, other visitors to the Expo are also welcome to attend.
