MALAYSIA, BRUNEI TO BUILD FIVE-STAR HOTEL AT KLCC

KUALA LUMPUR, Aug 28 (Bernama) -- Malaysia and Brunei have agreed to cooperate to build a five-star hotel at the Kuala Lumpur City Centre (KLCC), Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad said today.

He said the joint venture project would have the biggest convention centre in Malaysia.

" I've given the approval to build a five-star hotel near the KLCC. The Sultan of Brunei agreed to have a joint development for the project," he told reporters after sending off the Sultan at the Sultan Abdul Aziz Shah Airport in Subang.

Dr Mahathir said the Sultan was satisfied and happy on his four-day state visit to Malaysia.

He said Sultan Hassanal Bolkiah regarded his visit as very successful and expressed the hope to forge closer ties between the two countries through regular exchange of visits.

"We agreed to meet in Malaysia one year and in Brunei the next year," he added. -- BERNAMA
