MALAYSIA HOLDS MSC SEMINAR IN JEDDAH

KUALA LUMPUR, Nov 2 (Bernama) -- A seminar on Malaysia's Multimedia Super Corridor (MSC) will be held at an international hotel in Jeddah on Wednesday.

The Malaysian Consulate in Jeddah in a statement faxed here today said the seminar is to attract Saudis to invest in MSC.

Multimedia Development Corporation (MDC) Chief Executive Officer Tan Sri Othman Yeop Abdullah will give a briefing on investment opportunities in MSC.

A working paper will also be tabled by the Malaysian Security Commission in addition to video presentation and a question answer session.
