MB urged to explain about Aussie properties

KUALA LUMPUR, Sun. - The DAP today called on Selangor Menteri Besar Tan Sri Muhammad Muhammad Taib to explain about his properties in Australia as highlighted by an Australian daily yesterday.

Its secretary-general Lim Kit Siang said the Brisbane Courier Mail, in its report, stated that Muhammad and his wife, Puan Sri Asbi Rohani Asnan, were building a RM1 million house on a piece of land valued at another RM1 million in the Sovereign Islands.

Lim said the paper stated that three months ago, Muhammad and his wife had bought 4,500ha of cattle, sheep and grain property in Currajong Park in Western Queensland for RM5 million.

He said they were also interested in buying more properties worth RM12 million in Australia.

Muhammad, Lim said, must let Malaysians know the facts about all his properties in Australia.

The newspaper, according to Lim's statement, identified Muhammad as Umno vice-president and political adviser to Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad.
